# From the Prayer Team .... What's the Good of Prayer?

Have you ever secretly wondered that??? I wouldn't be surprised if that question hasn't crossed every Christian's mind at some point in their faith-journey. I would like to share some thoughts from a classic Christian author, Oswald Chambers. He wrote these words in a series of lectures given between 1911-1915 - over one hundred years ago - truth is timeless! He writes:



"Your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him." (Matthew 6:8)

"Then why ask? Very evidently our ideas about prayer and Jesus Christ's are not the same. Prayer to Him is not a way to get things from God, but so that we may get to know God.

When a man is born from above, the life of the Son of God begins in him, and he can either starve that

life or nourish it. Prayer nourishes the life of God. Our Lord nourished the life of God in Him by prayer. He was continually in contact with His Father. We generally look upon prayer as a means of getting things for ourselves, but the biblical idea of prayer is that God's holiness, purpose and wise order may be brought about.

As long as we feel we are self-sufficient and complacent, we don't need to ask God for anything. We don't want Him. It is only when we know we are powerless that we are prepared to listen to Jesus Christ and do what He says." (Oswald Chambers, from his book, <u>If You Will Ask: Reflections on the Power of Prayer)</u>

So, why should we pray? Answer -So we can get to know God! Prayer is the means of changing our imperfect hearts and wills to align with God's perfect will, so that God's holiness, purpose and wise order may be brought about on this earth!

I can't think of a more productive way for Christians to spend their time. I don't know about you, but I know I am powerless, and that is why I need to pray to the One who is all-powerful.

Come join me and our prayer team every Wednesday at 10:30 am so we can pray together and encourage one another!






We are glad you are here worshipping with us and you are encouraged to participate fully in the life of Trinity.
