From Pastor Bode - **If a Man Dies, Will He Live Again?**

Dear friends,

***"If someone dies, will they live again?" (Job 14:14a—NIV)***

Four hundred years before the birth of Christ, the renowned Greek philosopher Socrates drank the poison hemlock and lay down to die.

*"Shall we live again?"* his friends asked.

The dying philosopher could only reply, *"I hope so, but no man can know."*

Friends ... Socrates was wrong. Jesus Christ visited the realm of death ... He was *"crucified, dead, and buried."* But this time death was denied for *"the third day He rose again from the dead."* Today he proclaims to all who would believe Him: *"Because I live, you also will live."* (John 14:19b—NIV)

Easter is God's resounding and everlasting "Yes" to humanity's troubled question: *"If someone dies, will they live again?"*

Our belief in this great teaching of the resurrection of Jesus Christ is not based upon some religious feeling or upon an unfounded idea about what may have happened in the past. We are not basing our faith and Easter celebration on unsubstantiated rumors or spurious witnesses. The resurrec-

tion of Jesus Christ is one of the most well-established facts of history with solid evidence to support it that would stand up in a court of law. Our faith in Christ's promise of a life that will never end stands rock solid on the undeniable certainty of the empty tomb!

Confucius' tomb—occupied.

Buddha's tomb—occupied.

Mohammed's tomb—occupied.

Jesus' tomb—empty!

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is a reality ... a reality that offers you a irrefutable answer to the age-old question: *"If someone dies, will they live again?"*

*"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In His great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you, who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time." (1 Peter 1:3-5—NIV)*

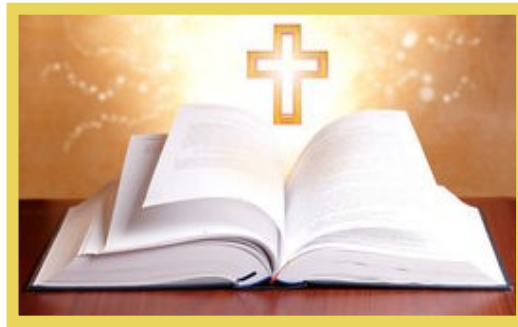

1,800 Treasure Coast families to their tables this Easter.**

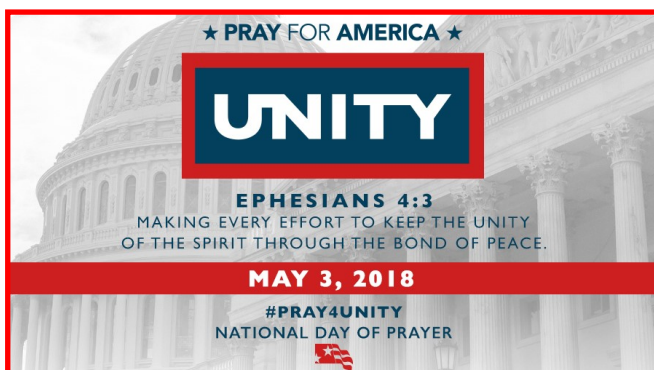
